Student Guidelines

Dress Code:

Day 1 - Attire

- Males: Suit, dress shirt, tie, belt, dress shoes with socks (Suits are not mandatory, but dress shirts with ties, dress slacks, belts, sock and dress shoes are required for male students)
- Females: Pant suit or dress, dress shoes with stockings. No bare legs.

Day 2 - Business Casual

- Males: Nice shirt, blue jeans (no ripped or torn jeans), belt, and tennis shoes
- Females: Nice blouse, blue jeans (no ripped or torn jeans), belt, and tennis shoes

Behavior & Conduct:

In all learning environments, there is a deportment that is expected from those in attendance. Here are reminders for such deportment at the Spring Break Leadership Summit.

- No cellphone usage during the Summit. Keep it "TURNED OFF," unless told otherwise by Summit leaders.
- Use titles of respect when addressing adults. (ie. Yes, Sir....)
- Be polite and courteous to peers and adults (ie. May I, please... Thank you... Nice to meet you.....)
- Cellphones must be turned off during the Summit, unless being used for a session (There will be FUN with the PHONES!)
- No profanity or inappropriate conversation
- Be responsive when given a directive from a Summit Instructor or Summit staff
- No runarguments, fights, or weapons are allowed (The Police will be phone, immediately, and all parties must leave and not return to the Summit)
- Represent yourself, family, and school well

Facilities:

With that being communicated, here are reminders for the two days that we will be hosted at these beautiful facilities.
